THE ST LUCIE RELAY FOR LIFE EVENT

The St. Lucie County Relay for Life goal this year was to raise \$100,000. It raised \$110,000. Money to help find a cure for cancer. Thanks to all who participated and contributed.

Cody Denig, a brave ten year old Cancer Survivor, started a School District Fundraiser and Cancer Awareness campaign, called the **“Circle of Hope.”** This event raised over \$12,000 and had over 30,000 participants. Cody’s older brother Matthew is the PSL Relay Youth Committee chair and arranged for all of the Children’s Activities at the Relay.

He was able to get the rides and activities donated. Ted and Rosemary Moschitta have kept in contact with Cody’s family, especially when Cody had surgery in Houston this past December. Ted learned the Saturday morning at the closing of the Relay that when Cody first met him at one of the monthly meetings, **Cody commented that Ted looked like a Grandpa.** Cody does not have any grandfathers.

Coincidentally, Ted does not have any grandsons. He has two grown granddaughters. Ted is thrilled to be **“Honorary Grandpa”** to Cody and Matthew.

As you probably know, Ted Moschitta stepped down as Team Captain of the Lake Forest Relay for Life Team, which has been taken over by the Co-team of Captains, Carl and Barbara Monge.

When Cody found out that Ted was “retiring” he asked Ted to be part of his team and work with him for their common goal to end cancer. Ted knew that he would always be part of The Relay. It is an important part of his life, just as it is for Cody. Ted has agreed to Cody’s request, and is delighted to be working on the same team as his “new grandsons.”

UPDATING HOUSE COLORS

During the past few weeks, I have been consulting with Sherwin Williams Paints & Color Wheel researching original colors used on the exterior of homes during the construction of Lake Forest at St Lucie West. **A folder is now available at the office for resident viewing**, listing all exterior colors. The only colors that will be approved are your original color, trim and door of your home.

I also have a color match for the tan, red and gray pavers, and concrete driveways. Keep in mind when painting your driveways, it will peel in time.

It is recommended that you do not paint your driveways, but pressure wash, then use a clear sealer after it dries.

An Architectural Application must be filled out for approval before you do any of the above work.
