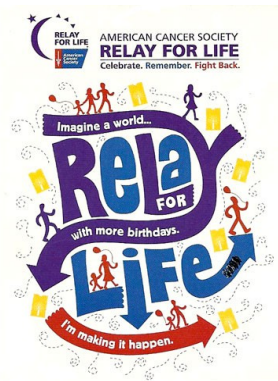

Welcome to the first official newsletter, which is dedicated to Mr. and Mrs. John Moore! Through this newsletter, its my goal to share information with you on a regular basis regarding projects, events and happenings in our great city!

City Council Notables

- At the March 24, 2014 City Council meeting, a [new fertilizer ordinance](#) was adopted. PSL has joined with other municipalities across our region to implement this ordinance so we can do our part in protecting our waterways.
- Sidewalks are a priority! At the February City Council/Staff Retreat, City Council reviewed the budget for sidewalks and increased the budgeted amount from \$250,000 to \$800,000 in order to provide funding for four sidewalk projects. [Download the presentation](#)

Important Projects

- Crosstown Parkway - At the end of February, the city received the Record of Decision (ROD) for the Crosstown Parkway Extension. The ruling means the city can move forward with property acquisition efforts and construction of several environmental improvement projects in state recreation areas that must be completed before construction of the bridge begins. In preparation for the issuance of the ROD, the city has been developing [design plans for the bridge and the improvement projects](#). Stay tuned for more updates on this top priority project!
- The [single stream recycling program](#) is being implemented! New single stream recycling carts are being delivered to residents. Recycling pick up utilizing the new carts begins May 1, 2014.
- Floresta Dr. Roundabout and Canal Park Improvements (Floresta/Southbend Blvd.) Construction is currently underway and is scheduled to be completed in November of this year. [Get details](#)
- Swale liner installations are happening throughout the city in several locations:
 - South Macedo Blvd. and South Biltmore from Thornhill to Whitmore Dr.
 - North of California Blvd. on both sides of the Monterrey Waterway and between Lennox St. and

Certosa Rd.
– Section 21, east of PSL Blvd., north of Paar Dr.

- Canal Bank stabilization for the E-8 Canal. This is a grant funded project to restore canal banks after damage sustained by Tropical Storm Isaac.
- Night paving work beginning April 7 through April 10 in the Darwin area from Tulip to Kaabe Ave. between Darwin Blvd. and Hale St., and Alcantarra Blvd. from PSL Blvd. to Savona Blvd.

Important Discussions on the Horizon

- At the City Council/Staff Retreat in February, discussion began regarding development of Becker Road. The question was asked, What should Becker Road look like? I have heard from many people that they would like to have limited development, i.e., convenience stores, pharmacies and gas stations. I feel it is important to balance the needs and wants of the residents in this area when considering commercial development and I would like to hear from you. The City Council will be presented with options at the April 11 workshop which is held at the Community Center.
